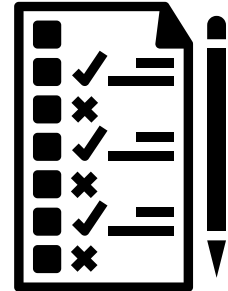


ACTIVE SHOOTER RESPONSE GUIDE

CALL **911** WHEN IT IS SAFE TO DO SO

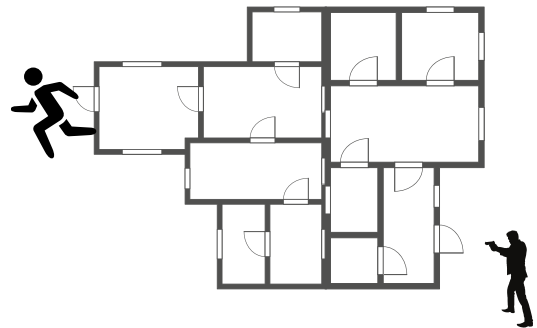
PREPARE

Be aware of your surroundings, educate yourselves, train and develop a response plan before an incident occurs.



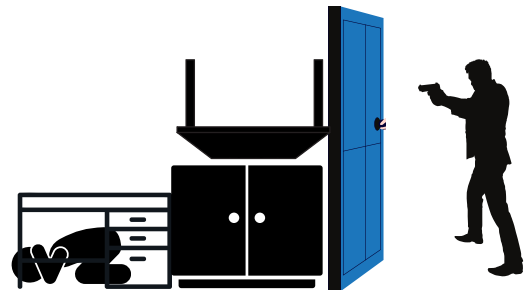
RUN

Evacuate by quickest means, if and when it is safe to do so.



HIDE

Seek cover and concealment, barricade yourself in a safe place, locking doors and remaining silent.



FIGHT

As a last resort, fight for your life by defending yourself from physical harm and rendering necessary medical treatment.



WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN CALLING 911

When you call 911 be ready to answer the following questions:

- Nature of your emergency
- Physical Address
- Information about the individual(s) threatening to harm others
- Physical description
- Last known location
- Types of Weapons
- Your locations
- Your ability to evacuate
- Your ability to safely shelter in place
- Medical Concerns

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM RESPONDING LAW ENFORCEMENT

A Law Enforcement Officer's initial responsibility is to eliminate the threat before assisting with injuries or medical related trauma.

- Remain Calm
- Avoid quick movements towards officers
- Follow directions
- Put down any items and keep your hands visible
- Provide any helpful information which may assist officers with eliminate the threat and to effectively render medical treatment.
